**StudyGlobal Virtual Education Fair:** On Sunday, April 12 from 9 a.m. to 12 noon, ICT (Vietnam time), we will offer a virtual fair that features two participation options. With the online option you chat with students and parents on a user-friendly platform with the assistance of a qualified Capstone student volunteer. There is also a "literature only" option with a carefully selected and trained Capstone student volunteer who greets visitors, answers basic questions, collects contact information for follow-up, and distributes digital promotional materials.

**NOTE:** There are two discounts for this event.

- Capstone partner: 5%. If you're not already a partner and are interested in becoming one, please let us know.
- Additional discount: 10%, if you also register for our Fall 2026 StudyGlobal Education Fairs.

**Fall StudyGlobal Education Fairs:** These events will be held in Hanoi, Ho Chi Minh City (HCMC), Danang and Nha Trang from September 25- October 1, 2026. The Danang and Nha Trang fairs are scheduled from 4:00 - 8:00 p.m., the Hanoi and HCMC fairs are scheduled from 2:00 - 6:00 p.m. (GMT +7). All fairs are held in four- and five-star hotels that are well-known to students and parents.

There are five (5) participation options to accommodate every schedule and budget.

1. **In-person participation:** You travel to Vietnam to represent your institution. (USD 1,700 per fair)
2. **Use of an in-country representative:** This includes alumni, parents, and staff. (\$1,700)
3. **Online participation:** If you can't travel to Vietnam, this is a great way to connect with students and parents at our fairs with the assistance of Capstone student volunteers. One volunteer will be at the venue to greet visitors, collect contact information for follow-up, answer basic questions, and distribute promotional material; another will be in one of our offices to facilitate the conversation and act as an interpreter. (\$1,300)
4. **Student ambassador representation (NEW!):** A carefully selected and trained Capstone student volunteer greets visitors, answers basic questions, collects contact information for follow-up, and distributes promotional materials. (\$1,000)
5. **Literature only:** Your institution's promotional materials are displayed on a dedicated table and included in every fair bag given to attendees. The table includes a sign-up sheet and QR code for anyone who wants to leave their contact information for follow-up. (\$500)

#### **Discounts:**

- Early bird: 5% if you register by May 15, 2026
- Capstone partner: 5%
- Multi-city: Three (3) cities: \$4,950 USD, Four (4) cities: \$6,450 USD
